

**MAINPOWER TRUST
PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO TRUST DEED**

1. The trustees have applied to the High Court at Christchurch for an order conferring on them the power to amend the Deed of Trust dated 27 January 2016. Previous notice has been given of the application and how beneficiaries can review relevant documents, provide comments or be heard in relation to the application.
2. Any party wishing to oppose the application or appear for an ancillary purpose is required by 15 September 2016 to file and serve a statement of defence or appearance along with evidence (if any) in support.
3. Mr T C Weston QC has been appointed to represent those who wish to oppose, or who may oppose, the application.
